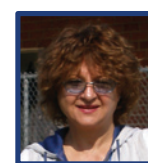

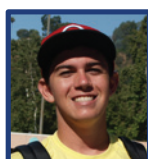

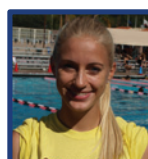

- Can I schedule a Camp tour?**
Yes, 30 minute Camp tours are available from 4:00pm-6:00pm on Monday, April 15th; Wednesday, April 24th; Friday, May 3rd; and Thursday, May 9th. Reservations are required. To schedule a tour, email camp@rosebowlaquatics.org or call 626.564.0330 x433.
- What are the facilities like?**
At Camp we have two Olympic size swimming pools, access to beautiful Brookside Park, shaded arts and crafts area, air-conditioned rooms and access to baseball fields, soccer fields, football fields, a jungle gym and a shaded picnic area.
- Can I create my own schedule?**
YES! You can create your own schedule. There is no minimum number of days per week or weeks per summer.
- What does tuition cover?**
Everything! All field trip entrance fees are included in the tuition, and campers are not allowed to bring money to Camp, except on the Knotts Berry Farm and Angel Baseball Game trips.

Anderson Adventure Camp H2O Counselor In Training Program

For ages 14 and 15. CIT's must be interviewed and selected for the program.

The CIT program is designed to give teens the opportunity to develop leadership skills and work experience. Some schools will even accept their volunteer hours as community service hours, which many high schools now require. In order to be eligible to interview to become a CIT, participants must be 14 or 15 years of age and attending high school. If selected, participants must attend at least 2 consecutive weeks of camp (5 full days per week). The hours of the program are 8:00 am - 3:30 pm (extended hours are available, if needed). The tuition for the CIT program is \$50.00 per week, which includes two CIT shirts that must be worn each day.
