A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners.

We have been blessed this past year by the generous sharing of your time, talent, and treasure that now we can offer God a bountiful harvest. Your faith and trust were the fertile ground that received the seeds that the Lord scattered at Holy Family. Thank you and together let us thank God for the wonderful

work that He has done among our family of faith.

A year ago, about this time we began planning our Faith in Our Future Campaign. We needed to raise \$8 million. In less than a year and with your generous response, we exceeded our goal and now we are looking forward to starting the first phase of construction, the school's basement remodel, in less than a year. Blessed be God for He has been good to us and thank you for your generous support of the campaign. It was a big leap of faith for me to undertake this effort since I had been here just a little over a year. I recognize it was also a big leap of faith for you too, to trust me with this project. Together with the help of God we did it!

We raised the \$8 million for the campaign while growing our ministries and ending the year financially better than the previous year although with a small deficit. We all witnessed the increased Sunday Mass attendance, but most noticeably at the weekday Masses; people having to wait in line to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Stations of the Cross during Lent, and many other signs of spiritual growth.

We have been publishing in the bulletin specific details of how our dedicated staff and volunteers grew our outreach to the needy, provided formation opportunities and kept up with the maintenance of our physical plant. All of this could not have been done without you.

Everything was going well until June 24th when I got a phone call from the Nuncio informing me that Pope Francis has chosen me to be the Auxiliary Bishop of the San Fernando region. I am honored to have been chosen, but I am saddened that I have to say goodbye so soon. However, I leave thankful for the opportunity to know you, serve you and minister with you. I am confident that with the leadership of the new pastor, you will continue to grow as a community of authentic missionary disciples. Know that you will always be in my prayers and please keep me in yours.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION CHURCH

The dim economic environment of fiscal year 2022 to 2023 negatively impacted our collections and donations, resulting in a loss in total revenue of \$69,000. We are grateful that the loss was minimized by the continued generosity of our dedicated donors.

As part of our plan to save our resources, we embarked on costcutting measures that included using these resources in the most efficient way possible. We also scaled back our capital expenditures as needed. The resulting decrease in expenses of \$72,000 helped our bottom line to narrowly come up with a gain over last year of \$3,000.

HOLY FAMILY'S HELPING HANDS

We continue to extend a helping hand to those beyond our parish boundaries. Together in Mission, which helps many financially disadvantaged churches and schools in the Archdiocese stay open, is still going strong, and is especially needed at this time of continuing challenges. Mission Haiti is especially in need of our support now as gang violence racks the country. Thankfully, fiscal year 2022-2023 was blessed with a collection of \$356,000, all of which will sustain our Haitian brothers and sisters as they struggle to cope with daily living.

FAITH IN OUR FUTURE CAMPAIGN

While we are extremely grateful to everyone who has helped Holy Family stay a vibrant community, we also wish to thank all those who made our Faith in Our Future capital campaign a success. Through your generosity, we have exceeded our \$8M goal by \$178,000! We look forward to the day when we can start work on the Church and Education Center improvements.

LEGACY OF LEARNING




FAITH IN OUR FUTURE

First and foremost, we would like to express our heartfelt gratitude to the nearly 400 families who made sacrificial pledges and generous gifts to The Faith in Our Future campaign. With your support, we have exceeded our \$8M goal to seismically retrofit the Church building and upgrade the Education Center. As part of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Holy Family also participated in Called to Renew, dedicating \$835,000 to support the historic diocesan campaign.

Holy Family's Faith in Our Future campaign is the first capital campaign fundraising effort in over 20 years. Holy Family embarked on this campaign to help fund structural improvements to the church building and upgrades to the Education Center. The construction will take place over the next 3 years and we are happy to share updated drawings. We will continue to keep you updated as the projects progress.

- **Church:** seismic retrofitting, roof improvement, internal improvements
- Education Center: first floor expansion, modernizing library, upgrading science labs, façade upgrades

Thank you to all the campaign volunteers who have worked with parish and school leadership to build the vision for the campaign, shared the plans with our community, and invited families to join the success of Faith in Our Future.

CHURCH RETROFITTING

Just as those who came before us had faith in the future of Holy Family, we have faith that our parish will continue to serve as a spiritual home in South Pasadena for generations to come. Retrofitting is necessary to ensure physical stability and longevity for our church. We seek to uphold the beauty of Holy Family and ensure that our place of gathering and worship will always be a safe place for our people.

- **Seismic Retrofitting** ensuring that our building is updated to the proper safety standards, making the church less prone to structural damage during an earthquake. We hope to protect our people from harm.
- **Securing our Church Roof** the original roof serves as a reminder of our history, and we plan to secure it to provide the utmost safety for our parishioners. Additionally, the gutter system and water intrusion facilitation process will be improved.

As one of the oldest buildings on site, modifications to our church will be primarily aimed at increasing safety, ensuring that Holy Family will remain strong for the future.





OUR PLANS: THE EDUCATION CENTER

EDUCATION CENTER IMPROVEMENTS

We recognize that learning is far more than academics; rather, it encompasses spiritual, social, emotional and physical development. Our approach to teaching goes beyond that of textbooks, and our facilities must match our desire for excellence. This campaign will address our children's needs, instilling a lifelong love for Christ. We plan to improve our students' educational experiences. As technology evolves, so does our data-driven teaching methodology. Modernizing our education center allows us to target areas of improvement and develop students' gifts, allowing them to flourish.



- Innovation Space our science labs are going to be transformed into a flexible space that is better equipped for our new science curriculum. Students from Transitional Kindergarten—8th grade will be learning STEM-based methodologies and even conducting experiments in the realm of robotics and programming. The Innovation Space is designed to bring science and math from the textbooks to real life, creating an exciting learning atmosphere for our students.
- **Library** the new library will be a space focused on fostering a love of learning with new books and areas that encourage collaboration, community, innovation and reading. Nooks, furniture, and specialized seating will inspire students to curl up with a book. Along the sides we will be adding alcoves for small group instruction, one-on-one support and collaboration. This space can also be used to host guest authors. The whole library will have a more open feeling with added widows and natural light.
- Broadcast Area there will also be a space within the library focused on technology, where we will be adding a green screen and small recording studio to eventually allow for a school-based student news broadcast.
- School Entryway we plan on making our Education Center entrance more visually appealing and welcoming. As the first impression of our Education Center, the new entrance will be more prominent and beautified.
- **Wellness Space** a new Spanish courtyard will be constructed as a space that inspires tranquility, prayer and reflection. Students will be able to study, have lunch and enjoy this new wellness area.
- **Faculty Offices** our current facility poses challenges for our staff, who lack office space. New areas designated specifically for our counselor, athletic director, communications director, and nurse are a vital part of the campaign plans, enhancing collaboration.
