Expectations for Student use of iPads:

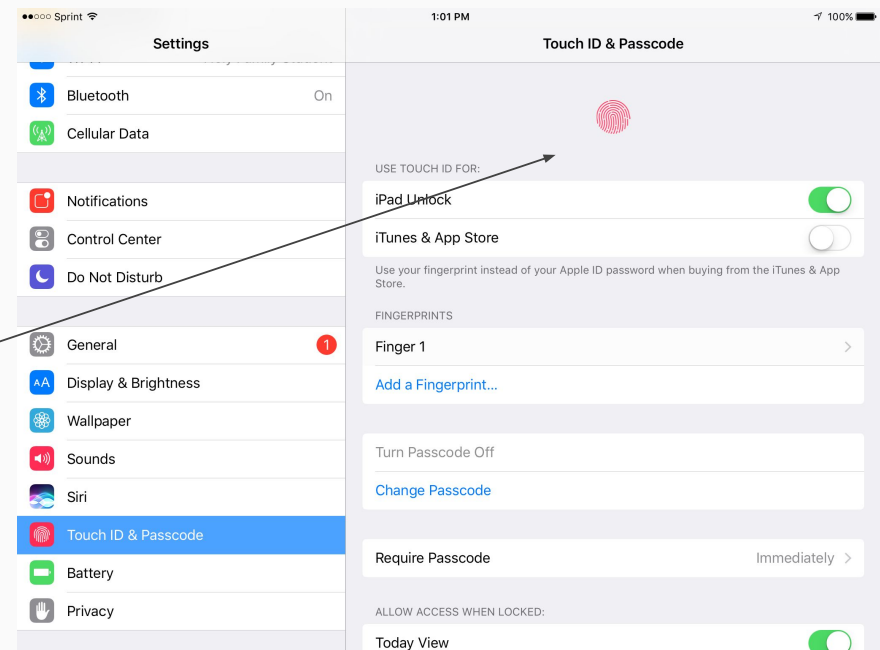
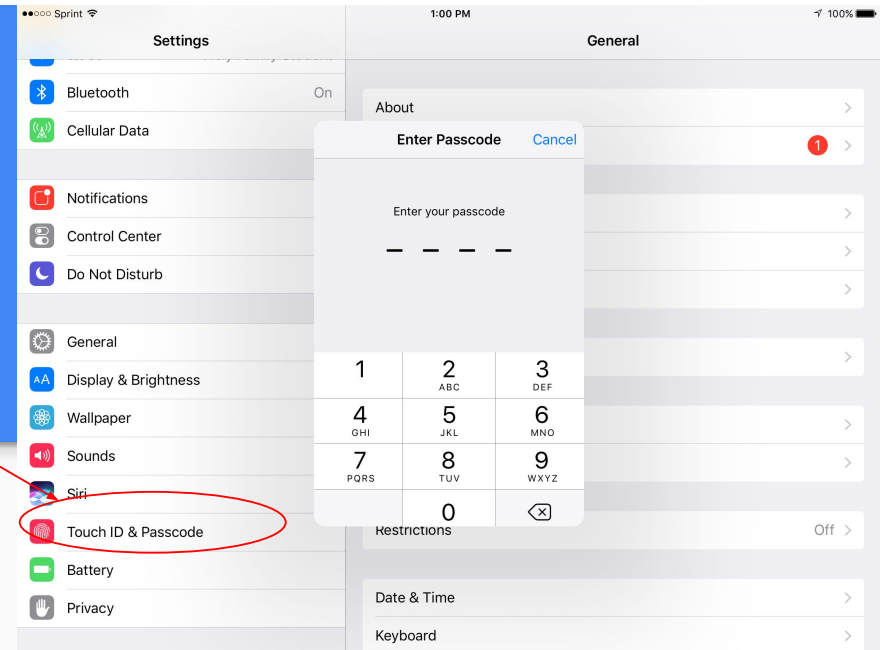
- NEVER Sign out of your Managed Apple ID
- Only use your HFknights email account- No personal email accounts allowed
- Keep the iPad in its Otterbox case
- Carry the iPad in a separate bag, not in a backpack with books.

As a Holy Family School Student:

- I will take good care of my iPad.
- I will never leave my iPad unattended.
- I will keep food and beverages away from my iPad.
- I will not alter the settings or apps on my iPad.
- I will bring my iPad to school every day with its battery fully charged.
- I will protect my iPad by only carrying it in an approved carrying bag.
- I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the iPad or case.
- I will not remove stickers or asset tags from the iPad.
- I will return the iPad in good working condition. I understand that any loss or damage to my school-issued iPad is my responsibility.

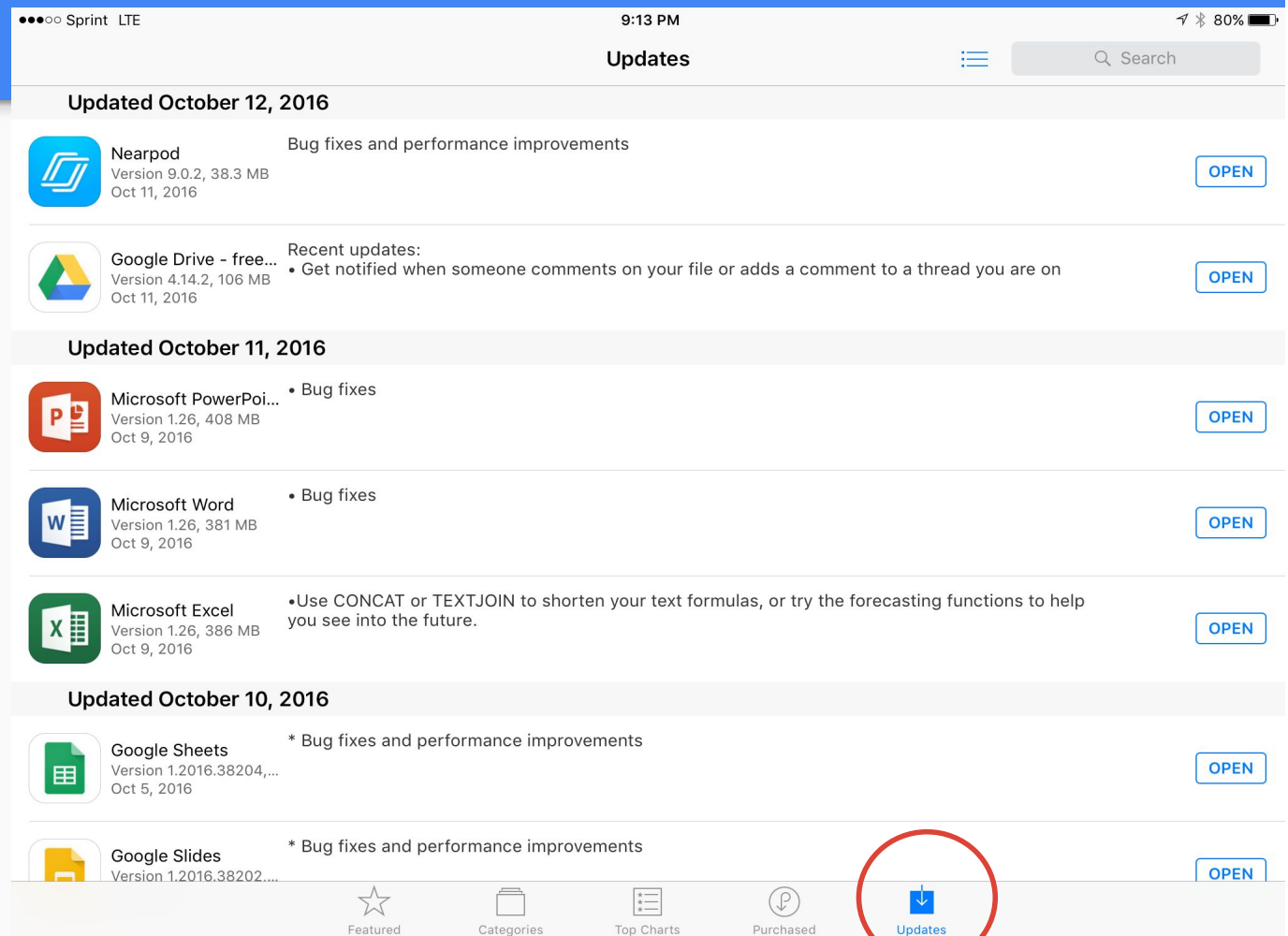


Settings: Updating Apps

Click update all.

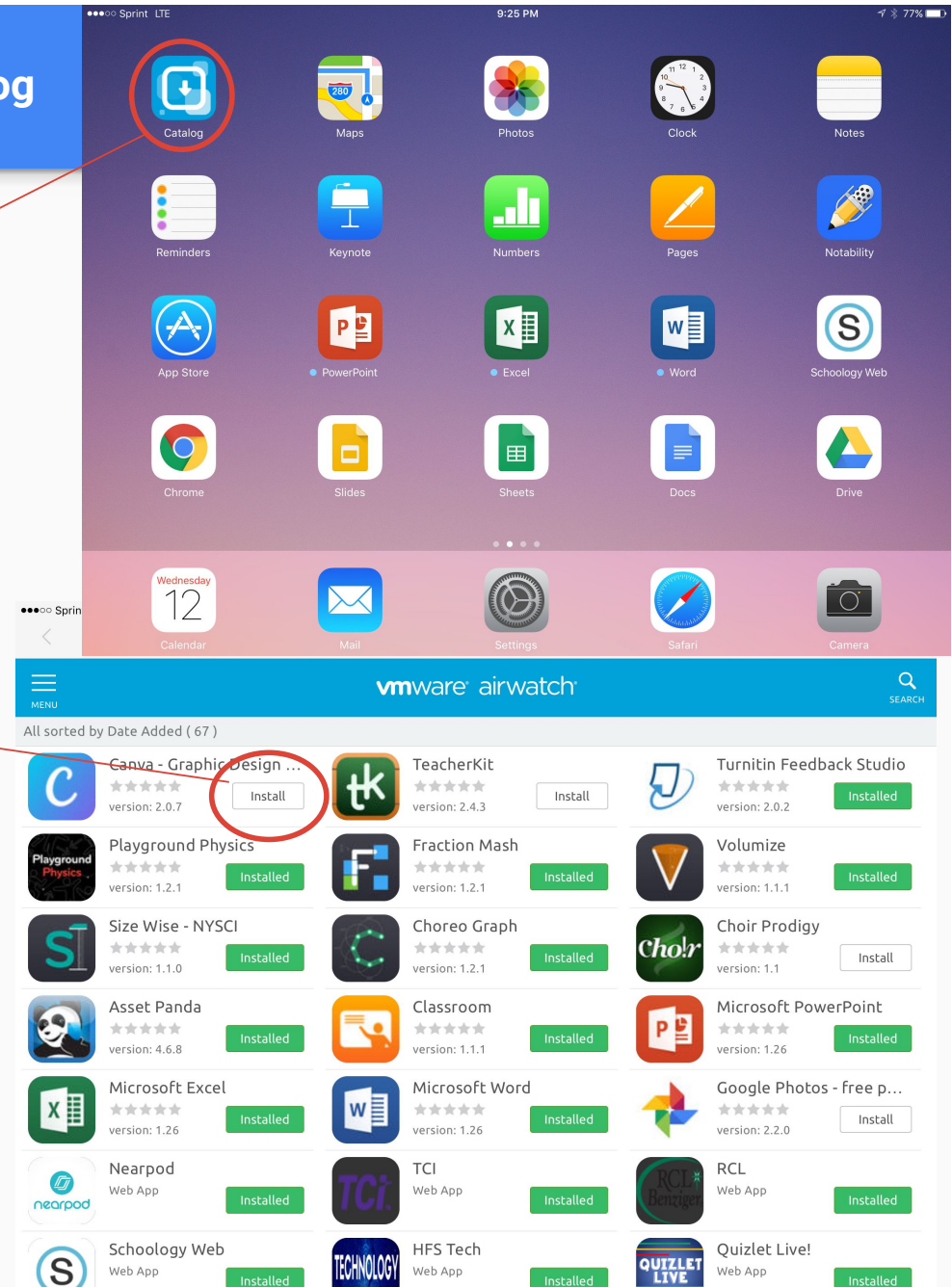


Downloading apps from the app catalog

First, open the catalog app.

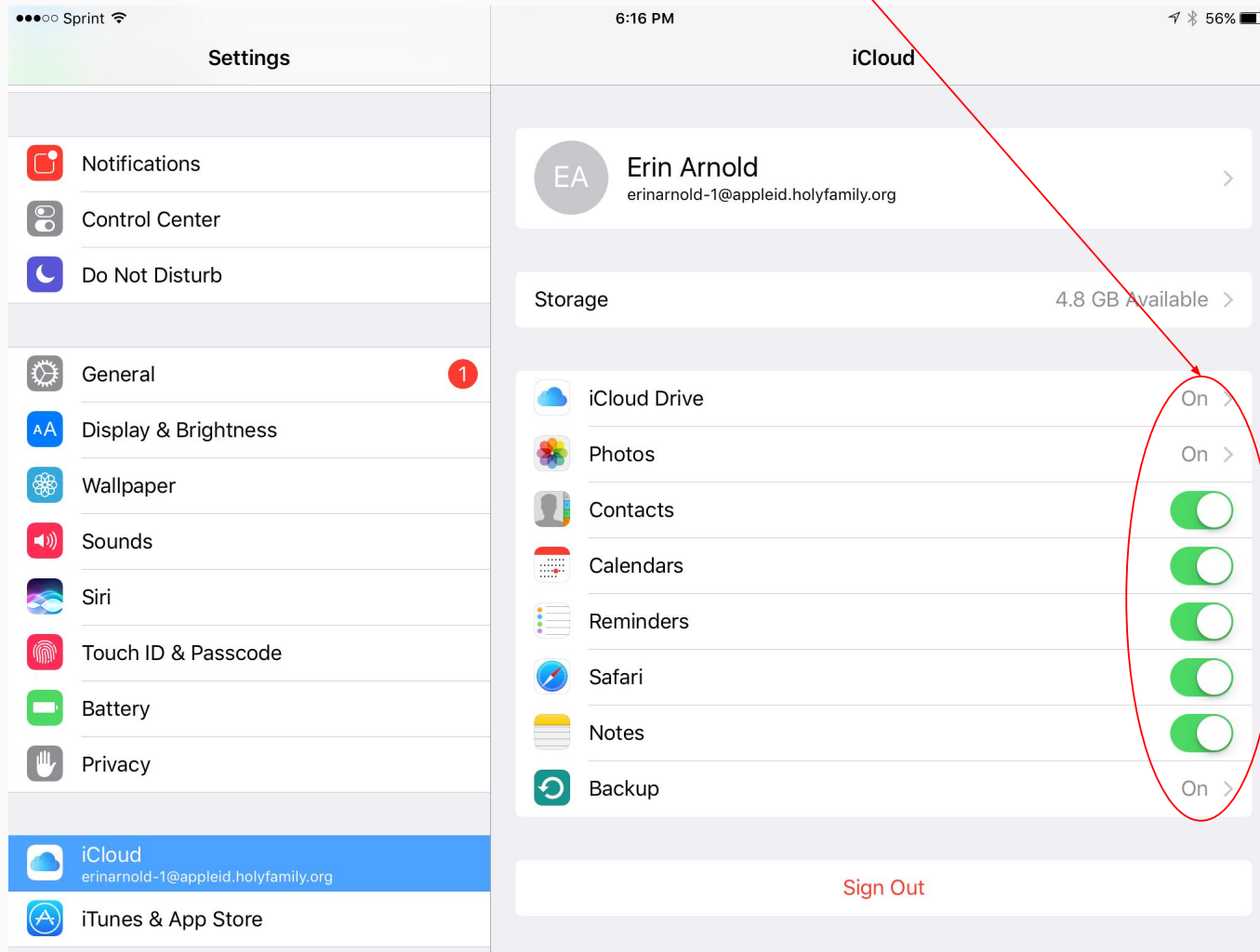
To install an app, simply touch "install" from the app catalog.

1. Open your Google Photos App

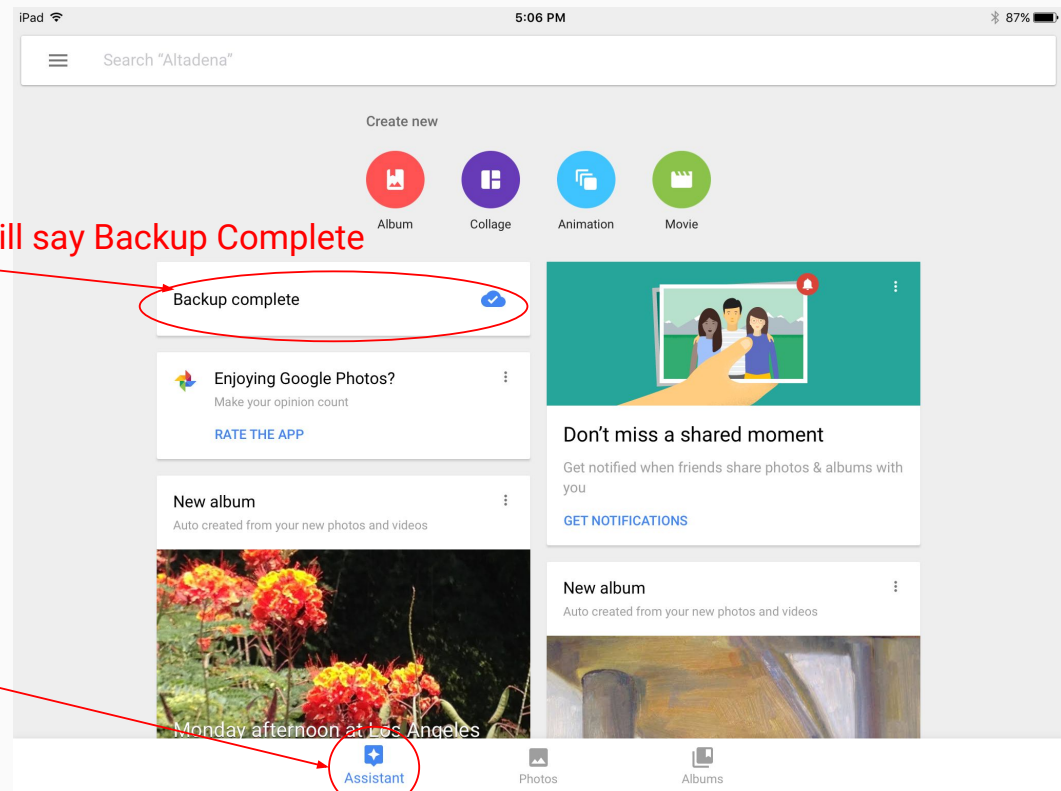


2. It will pull up your photos and Automatically start syncing them into a folder in your Google Drive

A note will be backed up in Notability's native ".note" file format.

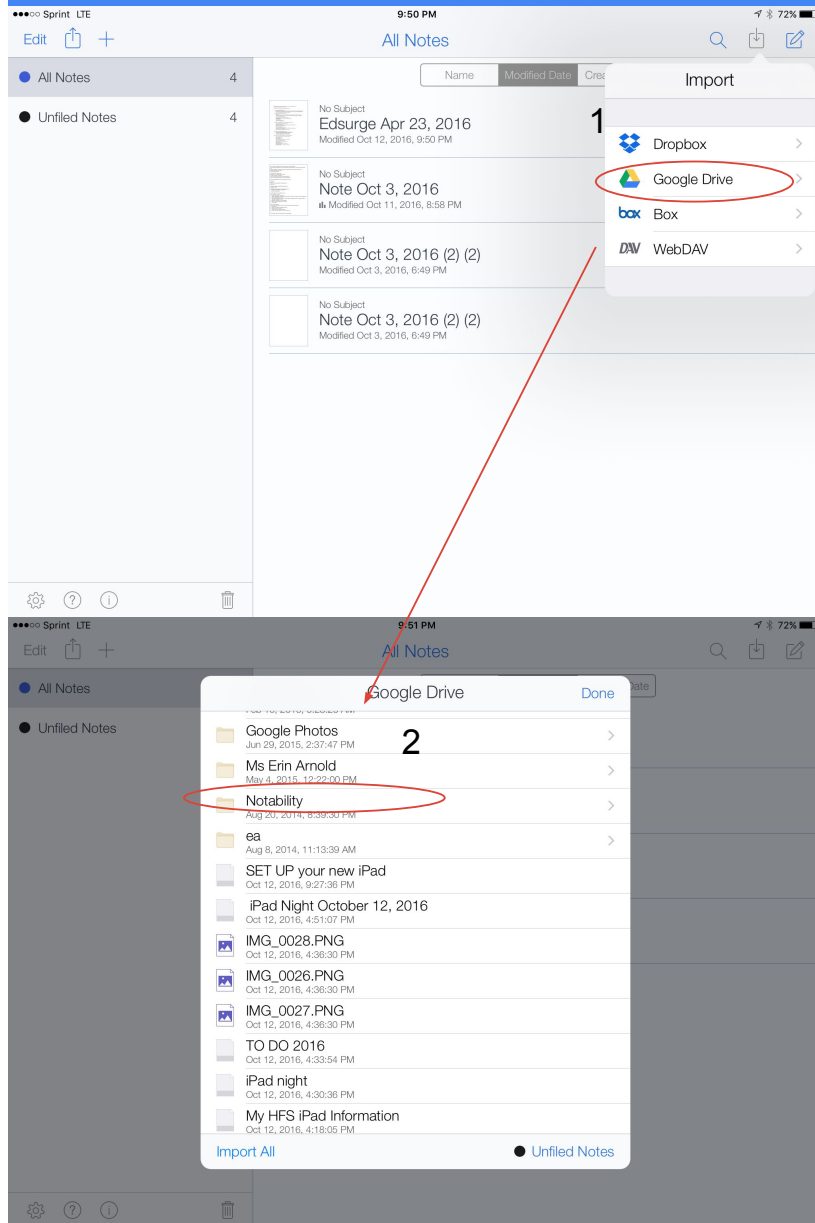
This file format includes every kind of content in a note: audio, handwriting, typed text, sticky notes, images, web clips, figures—everything! All of those contents are fully editable when the note is imported back into Notability.

This file format also keeps your audio recordings linked to your content.

This is the easiest option for sharing notes with other people who use Notability.

This is the easiest option for importing backups of your notes back into Notability.
